LedgeRock Golf Club is an exclusive 18 hole facility located near Reading, Pennsylvania. Laid against a palette of rolling hills blanketed with ancient hardwoods, LedgeRock will be challenging, yet rewarding, by design; dramatic to the eye and memorable to the end.

The course will stretch to a demanding 7,206 yards from the championship tees, with elevation changes adding to the excitement and beauty of each hole. Men will play from the green tees: 6396 yards and women will play from the gold tees: 5092 yards.

The course will present a new challenge with each round. As Rees Jones states,
